Mission Trip Participants - Release and Waiver of Liability for Short Term Mission Trip Form

I, the undersigned, will be participating in a short-term mission trip to Ghana, West Africa (hereafter the "mission trip") on or about July 27, 2022 to August 9, 2022.

I recognize that there are risks involved in participating in the mission trip and hereby assume all risk, furthermore I may not and will not hold liable in any way, and I hereby release, and I agree to hold harmless **Ghana Initiative Mobile Medical Mission**, its trustees, officers, directors, employees, agents and representatives from any claim by myself, my estate, heirs, successors, assigns or other persons arising out of my participation in the mission trip.

I authorize **Ghana Initiative Mobile Medical Mission** through its trustees, officers, directors, employees, agents or representatives to render or obtain such emergency medical care or treatment for me as may be necessary should any injury, harm or accident occur to me while participating in the mission trip.

MAY IT BE KNOWN THAT:

I understand and acknowledge that **Ghana Initiative Mobile Medical Mission** does not provide health or medical insurance in connection with the mission trip and I agree that I will be financially responsible for any bills incurred as a result of medical treatment, including emergency medical treatment and/or transportation to a medical facility, in connection with my participation in the mission trip. **(As a member of this mission team, you should check with your health insurance carrier to see if you have any overseas coverage, what deductible, co-insurance and out of pocket expenses are applicable, and as a precaution, purchase travel health/medical insurance through "Volunteer Card" if you don't already have such coverage in force from previous overseas travel within the last year and be cognizant of coverage limits and any co-pays etc. Such coverage is NOT a part of the application fee.)**

Please aware that Ghana is known for its heat, humidity and at times, rugged terrain. Emergency medical care is not immediately accessible in many of the areas that we serve and EMS does not function at the standards we are accustomed to in the USA.

I understand that I may be asked by the Ghana Initiative Mobile Medical Mission Chief Medical Advisor to provide written documentation from my family doctor stating that I am healthy enough to serve in a nation known for high temperatures, high humidity levels and rugged terrain for periods lasting more than 5 hours on a daily basis.
