Mission Team Guidelines

A team member should seek to maintain harmony within the group and be sensitive to others in the group who may not have the same standards or practices. There is no place for judgement or gossip while serving on a Ghana Initiative team. We seek to show the Grace of Jesus Christ to those we serve and our fellow team members.

Unmarried couples should refrain from cohabitating while participating on a mission team. A team member shall refrain from the use of illegal substances while participating on the team. A team member should refrain from excessive consumption of alcohol while serving with Ghana Initiative.
